Our initiatives include


- Employ a 0.6 Literacy Coach to support Prep to Year 3 teachers
- Employ Support Teacher: Literacy and Numeracy for an additional two days per fortnight
- Employ a 0.6 Specialist Arts teacher to release teachers to engage in weekly coaching and professional learning
- Employ at 0.2 Student Success and Wellbeing Coach to support the embedding of neuroscience, mindfulness and growth mindset across all year levels
- Engagement of Year 3 to 5 teachers in Feedback Research Study with the University of Queensland
